Track 2 Student Contract

General Guidelines:

- As part of the College Prep Program, students are expected to meet certain requirements to maintain their position. Volunteers are offering their time and effort to help students achieve academic and personal success, and it is a privilege to participate in this program. Therefore, proper behavior and involvement is required to continue as a member.
 - Disrespectful/disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
 - Attendance is mandatory (barring extenuating circumstances).

Specific Requirements:

- Attend all weekly sessions (or provide documentation excusing absence)
- Arrive on-time, prepared, and with a positive attitude for each session
- Attend all monthly workshops (or provide documentation excusing absence)
- Read and analyze 2 articles each month
- Treat mentor, other volunteers, and other students with respect
- Maintain at least a 2.5 GPA (anything lower will result in probation)
- Serve as a positive role model for younger students (academics and behavior)

Probation Protocol:

- If any of the above requirements are not met, the student will be placed under probation and face possible termination from the program.
- Students will be notified of any failure to comply with the requirements of this program and of their probation.
 - If disrespectful behavior continues during this probation period, the student will be banned from participating in the program.
- For academic probation, students will have the opportunity to improve their grades and continue the program.
 - Should the student not show progress or effort to improve grades within one month, a parent will be notified. If the situation continues, the coordinator will review the case and students may face termination.
